



RIDER RULES

To assure a safe and comfortable ride for all, the following policy regarding bus behavior will be strictly enforced.

Behaviors that are in appropriate on the bus include but are not limited to the following:

- Shirts and shoes required.
- No smoking.
- No hazardous, explosive, incendiary, or flammable materials or devices.
- Take a seat immediately and always stay seated.
- Eating, drinking, or playing music without earphones is prohibited.
- Keep feet and carry-on items out of aisle.
- Pets must be in cages.
- An adult or older child must accompany children under 11.
- No profanity or vulgarity or rude behavior.
- Bicycles in the bike racks only.
- Roller blades must be carried onboard.
- Baby strollers must be folded and placed out of the aisle.
- Exact change for fares is required. Drivers cannot make change.
- First row seats are reserved for the elderly and riders with mobility impairments.
- Passengers using wheelchairs must board through the front door on all buses.
- When approaching your destination, pull the stop request cord.
- Do not cross in front of the bus when exiting.
- No Fighting.
- No Spitting.
- Do not put feet on the seats or railings.
- Do not bother other passengers.
- Do not litter on the bus.
- Do not stand when seats are available.
- Do not change seats when the bus is moving.
- No Excessive noise.
