

PASSENGER WEAPON POLICY

March 5, 2018

It is unlawful for any person carrying, exhibiting, displaying, or drawing any firearm, dagger, sword, knife or other cutting or stabbing instrument, club, or any other weapon apparently capable of producing bodily harm, in a manner, under circumstances, and at a time and place that either manifests an intent to intimidate another or that warrants alarm for the safety of other persons, unless otherwise authorized bylaw (RCW 9.41.270).

In the event a customer boards or after boarding your vehicle displays a weapon, and the Operator perceives a potential threat, call Dispatch immediately. **DO NOT CHALLENGE THE PERSON WITH THE WEAPON.** Advise Dispatch what type of weapon, a description of the person on the vehicle, and whether a threat to you or your customers exists.

If unable to contact Dispatch, or the situation does not permit, operators have the authority to deny service or call 911 if deemed necessary.

An incident report must be filled out before leaving at the end of the work shift. If you have any questions, contact the Operations Manager, David Johnson.
